

## MUSEUM AT HOME

### Dragon-twigs

The propeller-shaped seeds from maple trees form the wings of these delicate dragonflies.



### What You Need:

- Twigs
- Tacky Glue
- Maple seeds
- Bead eyes or google eyes
- Glitter glue

### What You Do:

1. Get four maple seeds. Place four maple seeds on your work surface with their ends meeting as shown above.
2. Add a drop of tacky glue to each end.
3. Rest a 4-inch twig on top. Let the glue dry.
4. Turn over the dragonfly and add a line of glitter glue to the edge of each wing. Attach two small bead eyes or google eyes with glue.
